

Which is the best argentine tango database?

Here are the **leading Argentine Tango music databases and archives**, ordered by *scope, depth, and reputation* among DJs, collectors, researchers, and dancers:

1. TANGO-DJ.AT — Largest Digital Tango Music Archive

3. TodoTango — Broad Reference Resource

- A **free comprehensive tango music and artist site** with thousands of entries.
- Includes information about musicians, singers, lyrics, and scores.
- Not strictly a database in the DJ-archive sense, but extremely useful as a **reference index** with search and artist pages.

Best for: Historical research, finding artist biographies, lyrics, and context.

4. El 13 Database (El 13 Tango Club)

- A curated collection database maintained by El 13, emphasizing **quality sources and vintage releases** like Club Tango Argentino and major historical collections.

- Less automated metadata than Tango-DJ.AT but valuable for DJs seeking *best available versions*.

Best for: DJs and collectors focused on classical and essential tango recordings.

5. DYM Music Database (Danza Y Movimiento)

- A publicly listed music database showing categories for **tango, milonga, vals** (though less extensive than Tango-DJ.AT).
- Offers basic indexing and classification.

Best for: Casual exploration and cross-reference.
